as completely as a mother!





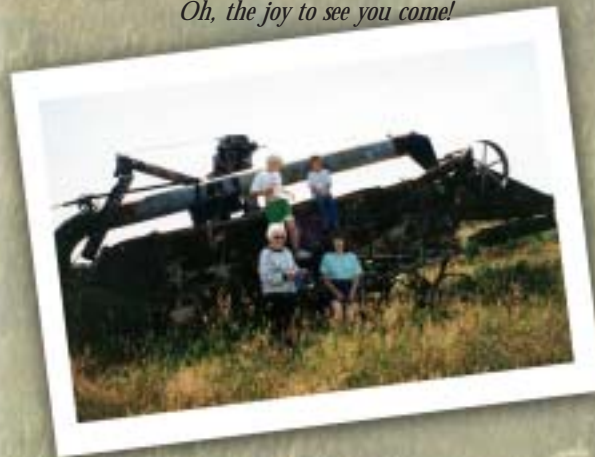

They returned to the Kary farm and Evelyn continued to teach at Country Schools. Evelyn taught religion classes at St. Edward's for many years, along with holding offices in the Altar Society. Her children and grandchildren were the center of her life. She also enjoyed sewing, gardening, her flowers, and decorating her home.
